Juergen Voegele, Planet Vice President, The World Bank

Juergen Voegele is Planet Vice President at the World Bank Group, where he leads global efforts on agriculture, climate change, environment, urban development, water, and related sectors. Since joining the Bank in 1991, he has held a range of leadership roles, including Senior Director for Agriculture and Global Director for Climate Change.

Dr. Voegele also chairs the CGIAR System Council and co-chairs the World Economic Forum's Global Future Councils. He holds a Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics and a Master's in Agricultural Engineering from the University of Hohenheim, Germany.



Sangbu Kim, Digital Vice President, The World Bank

Sangbu Kim is Digital Vice President at the World Bank Group, bringing over 27 years of leadership experience across public and private sectors. He has held senior roles in the Republic of Korea's President's Office, where he led national ICT initiatives in egovernment, broadband, digital literacy, cybersecurity, and trade policy, as well as in the Korean Communications Commission and Ministry of Information and Communication.

Sangbu's private sector experience includes serving as Director of Government Affairs & Public Policy for Consumer Products at Google Asia Pacific, and as Vice President for Corporate Strategy, Investment, and Partnerships at LG Uplus. A South Korean national, he holds a Master of Public Administration from Harvard Kennedy School and a Bachelor of Business Administration from Seoul National University.

Ministry of Economy and Finance (MOEF). He previously served as Deputy Director
