

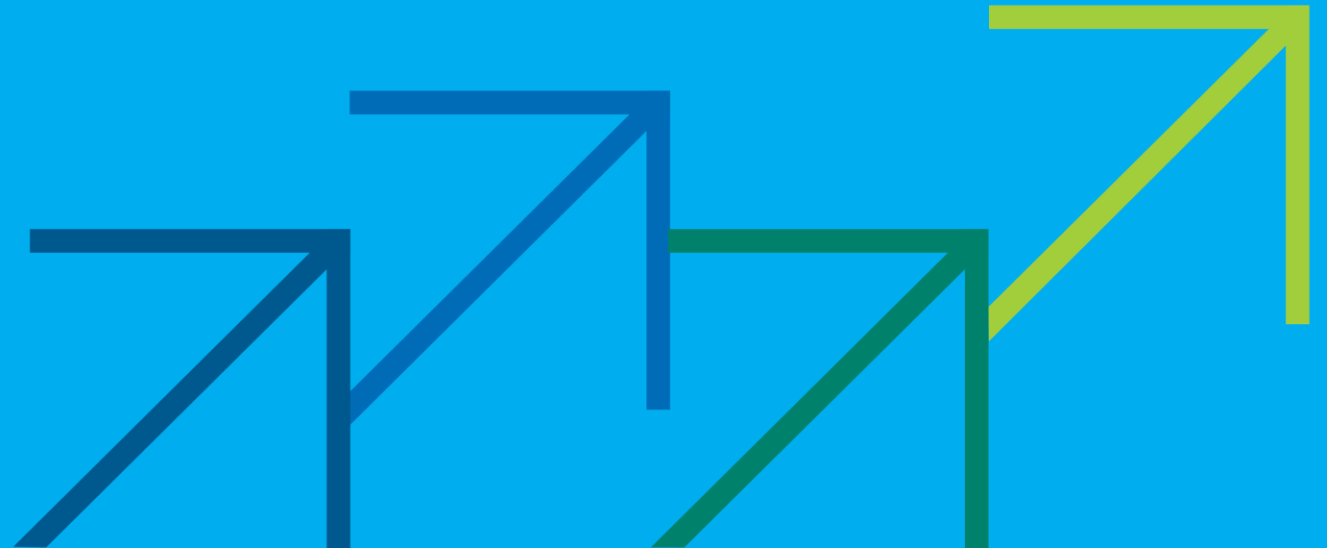

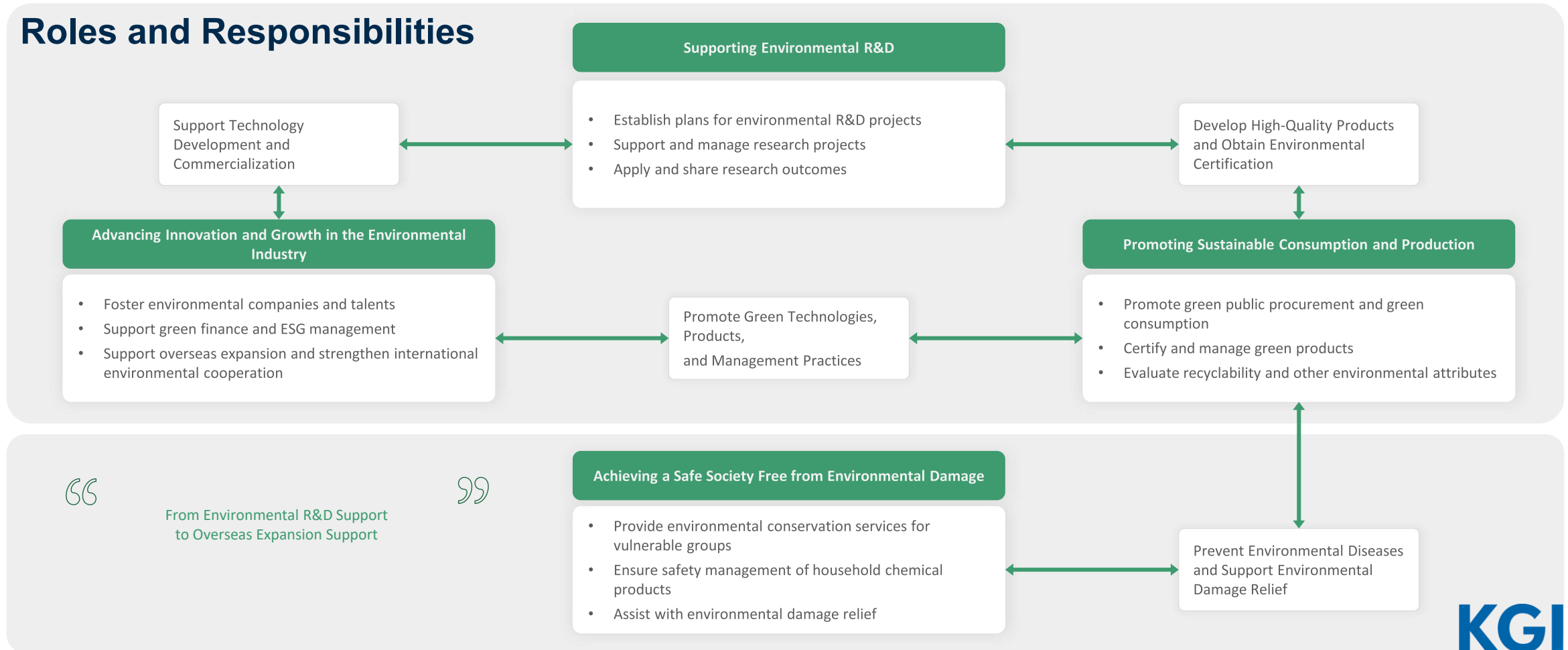

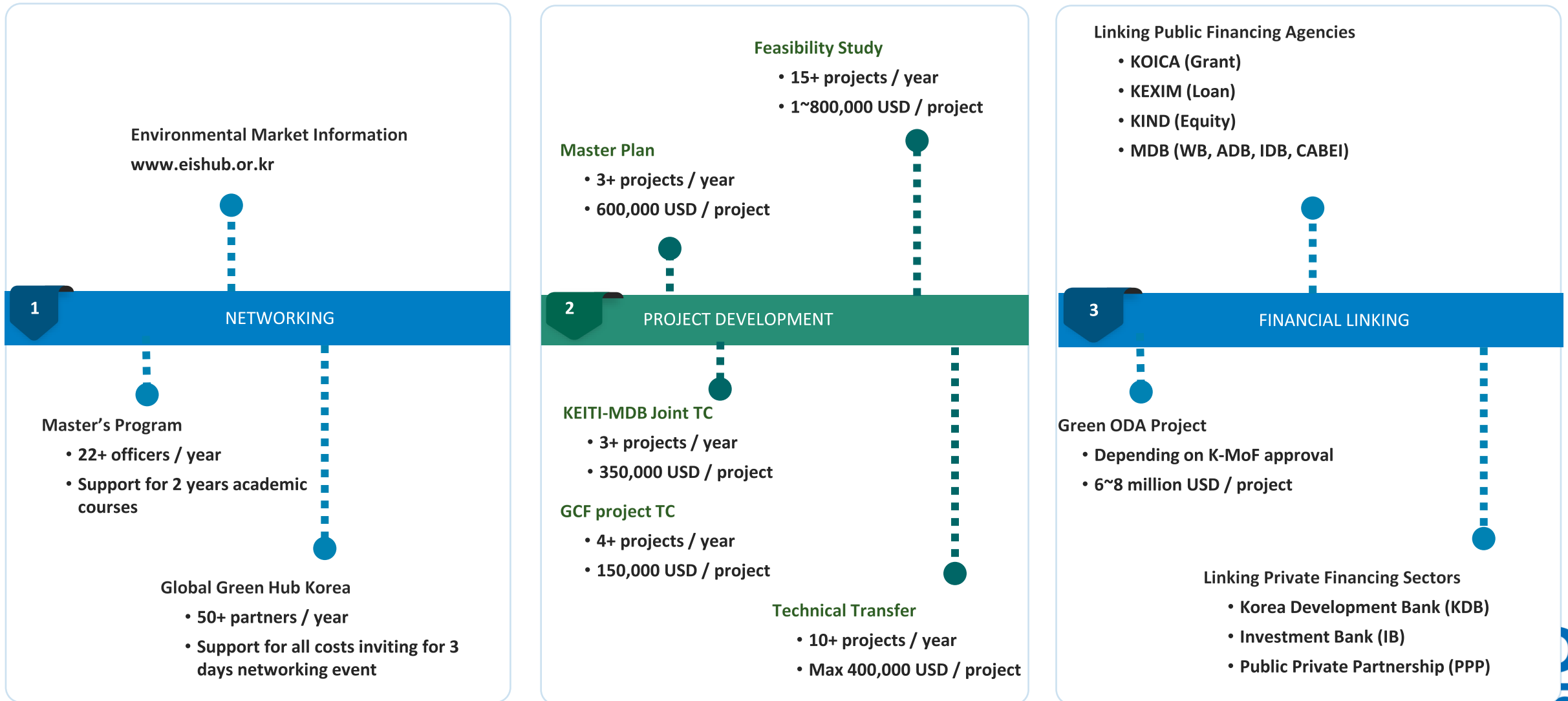

Historic Milestones in Global Cooperation Projects



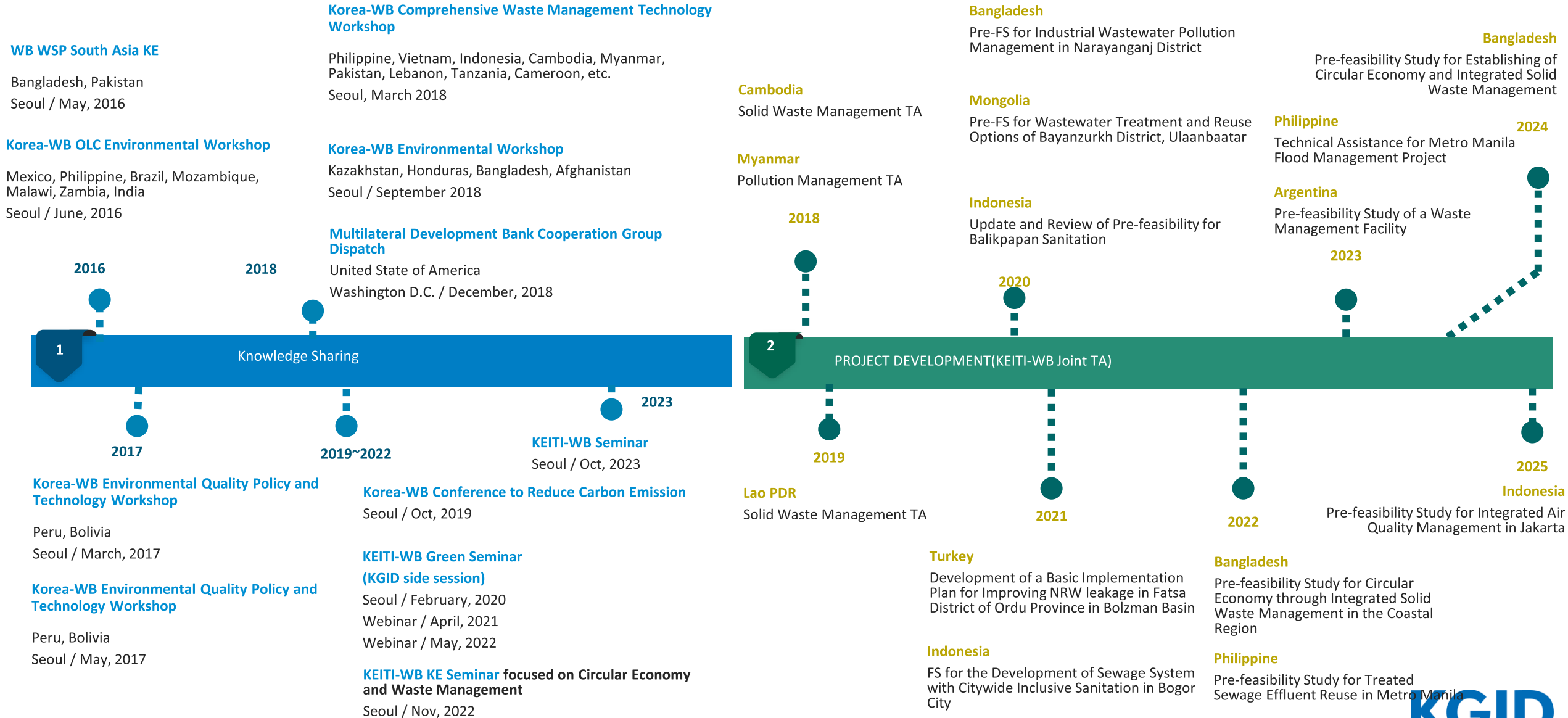

- Activity 2: Development of the concept-level plan for the design
- Activity 3: Pre-feasibility study for the wastewater treatment and reuse infrastructure

PROJECT BUDGET | USD 500,000

GRANT YEAR | Year 12 (from 2024)

SUMMARY |

Municipality of Ulaanbaatar City (MUB) in developing and implementing projects to mitigate flood risks and improve sanitation services, which will contribute to resilient and sustainable urban development.



Circular Economy for Waste Management in Province of Buenos Aires

PROJECT BUDGET | USD 600,000

GRANT YEAR | Year 10 (from 2022)

SUMMARY |

The overall development objective of the proposed APL program supports the Government's Integrated Basin Clean up while simultaneously improving sanitary conditions along the banks of La Plata River and providing a long-term and cost-effective solution for the safe disposal of wastewater from the Buenos Aires Metropolitan Area.

PROJECT PERIOD | Mar. 2023 ~ Mar. 2024

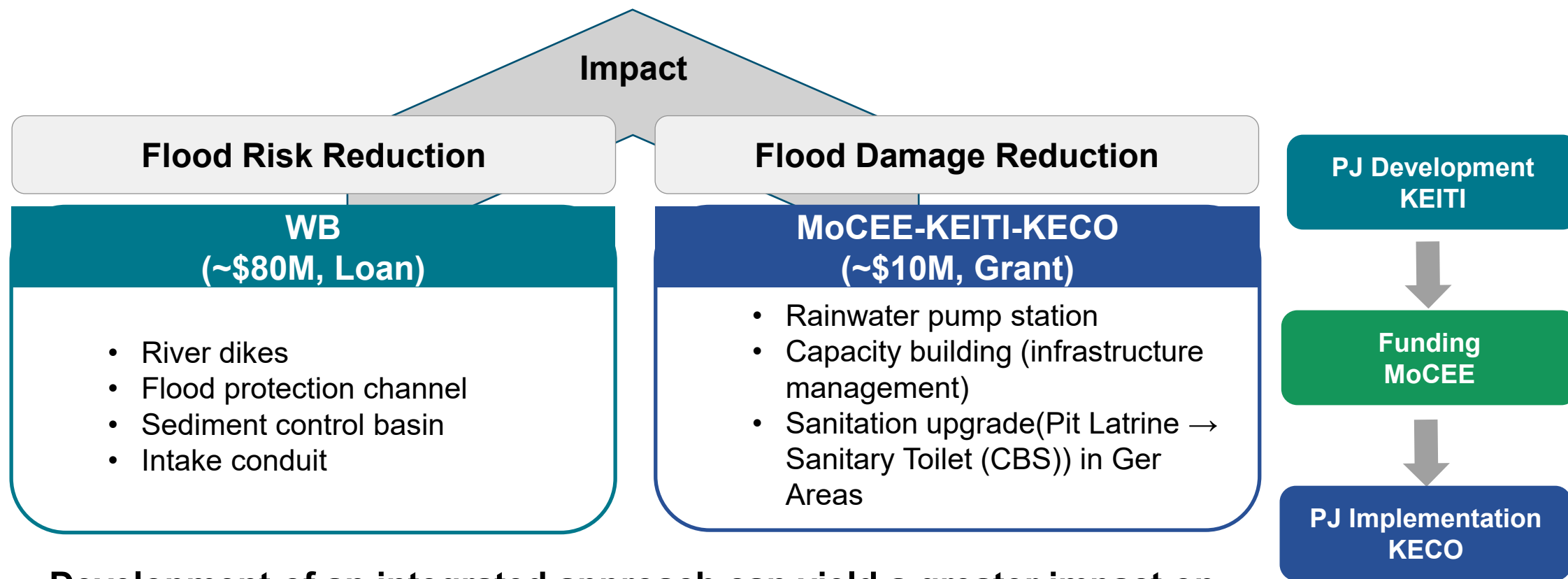
WORK SCOPE |

- Activity 3: Knowledge-sharing



Collaboration Case 2: Loan-Grant (Blend)

Citywide resilience: fewer floods, fewer losses, faster recovery



Development of an integrated approach can yield a greater impact on flood resilience in Ulaanbaatar

Proactive Expansion in Climate & Energy

With the launch of MoCEE (Oct 1), expand into climate adaptation, mitigation, and energy.

Linked/package projects to scale impact

TA–TA collaboration, TA→Loan linkage, Grant–Loan blended packages.

Project Pipeline Development in AI & Climate Tech

Provide mini-grants and field access for data collection and AI modeling pilots
