# Two Stages of Evaluation and Prioritization

## - Stage 1: Selection of Pre-Proposals by 7 WB GP Managements

- With prior clearance from Practice Managers, TTLs will complete and submit Pre-Proposals (two pagers) in the KGGTF Dashboard
- **Shortlisting:** Global Directors, supported by PMs, will shortlist up to 7 Pre-Proposals from each GP to advance to Full Proposal development

## - Stage 2: Selection of Full Proposals by the Donor

- TTLs of selected Pre-Proposals will develop Full Proposals in the Word document template and submit to KGGTF for final review
- **Evaluation:** The Full Proposal packet will be submitted by KGGTF to the Donor for evaluation and approval
